

## For existing pools prior to 1 January 2003

### After an Advice Inspection

A written report will be sent within two weeks providing details of the inspection and the decision of the *Swimming Pool Safety Authority*.

### Review of the Inspection Report

If you have any concerns with the written report you may:

#### OPTION 1

Self assess the enclosure to your swimming pool to determine whether or not it would meet the Community Safety Standards. Complete any work considered necessary and complete a Declaration of Compliance. To download an application form and guidelines please visit the Water Safety Website at [www.watersafety.nt.gov.au](http://www.watersafety.nt.gov.au) or contact the Water Safety Branch to obtain forms.

No further action required.

#### OPTION 2

Prefer to obtain a compliance certificate from the *Swimming Pool Safety Authority*.

STEP 1: Phone and discuss the report with the Pool Safety Adviser,  
or phone and ask to speak to the Pool Safety Manager.

STEP 2: Phone and discuss the report with the Director, Water Safety Branch.

STEP 3: Write to the *Swimming Pool Safety Authority* for a review of the report and decision who may, if satisfied that there is not an unacceptable risk to a child, exercise discretion under the *Act*.
